### The Founder

Based on the traditional Carmelite spirituality Blessed Kuriakose (Cyriac) Elias introduced the monastic life in Kerala. He founded religious congregations: Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI Priests) for men and the congregation of the mother of Carmel for women (CMC Sisters /nuns). As a result, monasteries and convents (the holy places where the people dedicated for God and men live) were started in Kerala. According to him there should be schools, colleges and other educational institutions attached to monasteries and churches. This concept paved the way for more Christian educational institutions in Kerala. As a result, literary level of Kerala reached hundred percent.

### The Management

St. Mary's School is an educational institution run by the Christian minority. It is managed by the Congregation of Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI), which is Asia's biggest indigenous religious congregation for men in the Catholic Church.
